Maintaining the Health and Safety of All

The District will continue to follow all required mandates related to COVID-19 in order to maintain the health and safety of all students, faculty, staff, and stakeholders of the District.

Masks

The Midland School District **strongly recommends** the wearing of masks by students, faculty, and staff when advised to do so by the Arkansas Department of Health.

Social Distancing

When necessary and when possible, social distancing of 6' is recommended.

Handwashing

Students, faculty, and staff will wash hands or use hand sanitizer frequently throughout the day. Hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout all Midland facilities.

Cleaning/Disinfecting

Midland facilities will be regularly disinfected and sanitized to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Surface cleaners and foggers will

be used in classrooms, cafeterias, gyms, and buses when the threat level of COVID-19 is great.

Contract Tracing and Quarantines

The Midland School District will follow Arkansas Department of Health and DESE guidelines concerning tracing and quarantines.

Screening

The Midland School District will follow Arkansas Department of Health and DESE guidelines concerning screening.

Vaccinations

The District has no official position on vaccines. The District has offered an incentive to employees who have taken the vaccine. Additionally, the District has advertised various clinics on its website and Facebook page.

Accommodations

Students with IEPs or other plans that allow for modifications or accommodations will be served in the way prescribed by those documents.

Coordination with State and Local Officials

The District will continue to work with the Arkansas Department of Health to report required information and for guidance in case of an emergent situation within our District.
